

GENERAL ROUTE DESCRIPTION

The main paths are all tarmac or stone, over 2m wide and level. There are no surfaced paths where slopes have gradients steeper than 1:25 and only one cross-slope greater than 1:33. There are some width restrictions at the site entrances. There is approximately 1.5 kilometres (0.93 miles) of surfaced paths.

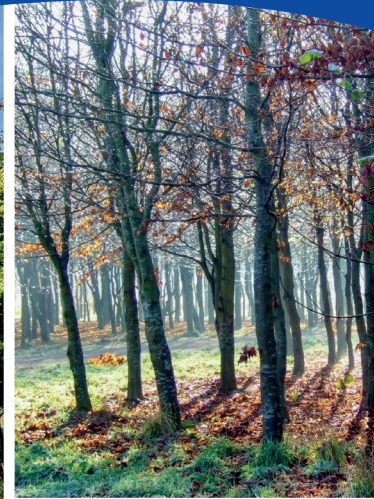

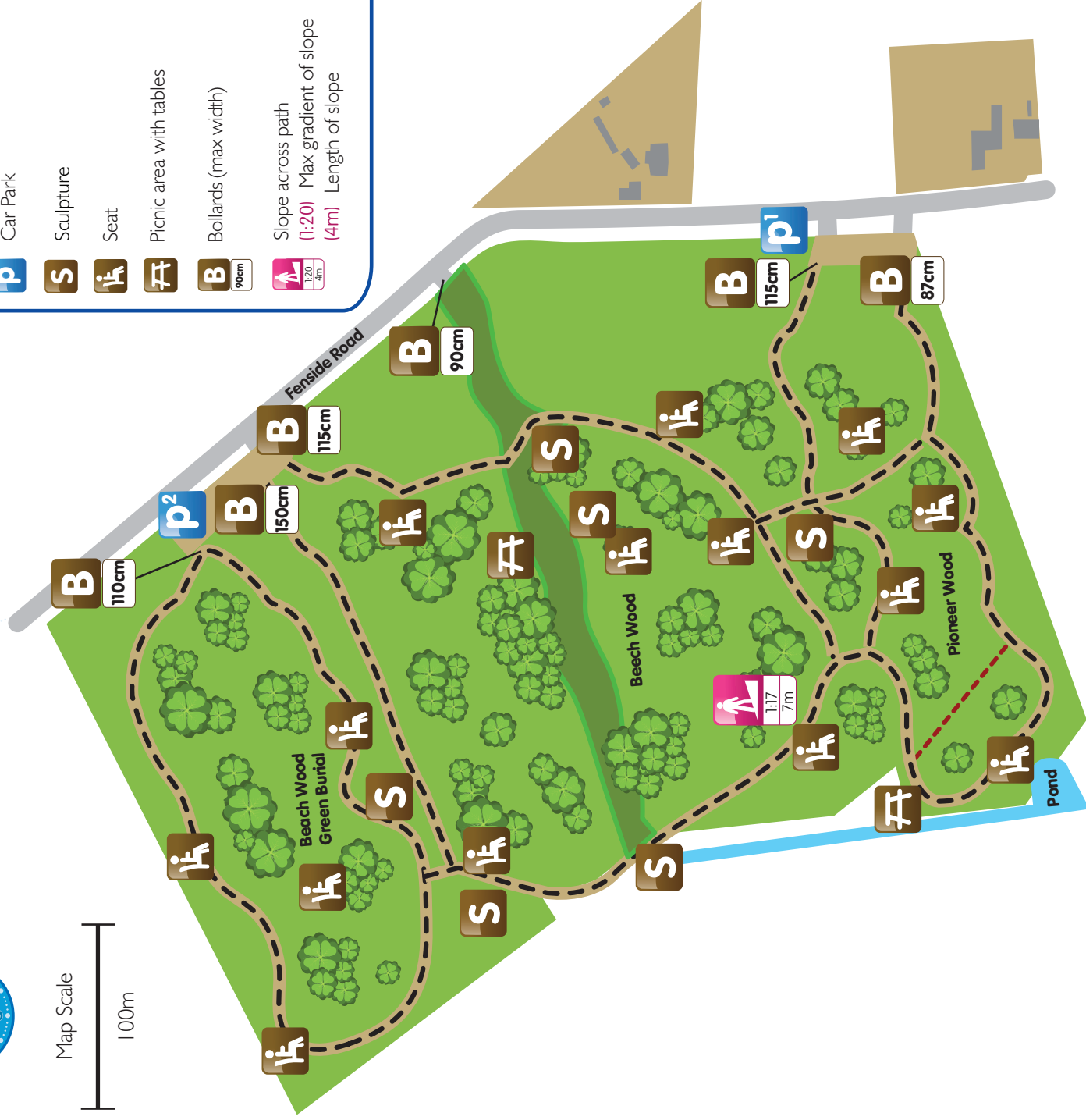
The 23 acres of Beech Wood are made up of three sections. The established central section is predominately beech wood, flanked on the south by Pioneer Wood with its pond and small amphitheatre whilst the area on the north side is home to Beech Wood Green Burial. Look out for the chainsaw carvings.
